Highlights to Prairie Villas Covenants, Conditions & Restrictions MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITIES

I. Association Responsibilities – Prairie Villas HOA:

- 1. Common areas:
 - > Trees Planted by Whitaker or Association (prune, fertilize, leaf clean-up)
 - ➤ Shrubs Planted by Whitaker or Association (prune & fertilize)
 - ➤ Planting Beds Located by Whitaker (pre-emergent & mulch)
 - ➤ Lawns (mow, edge, fertilize, weed control, aerate & overseed)
 - ➤ Irrigation (start-up, backflow test, maintenance & winterize)
 - ➤ Snow & ice removal 2 inches or more snow (driveway, walkway to front entry & entry)
 - ➤ Mole or Vole control (chemical application as required)
 - > Entry Monuments and Center Median.

2. Exterior components:

- Roof shingles & vents
- Gutters
- Downspouts
- Exterior building surfaces (brick or vinyl siding)
- Power washing

3. Painting

All exterior trim surfaces not covered by vinyl siding (Staining of steps, stairways, decks, screened-in decks, seasonal rooms and support posts is not included.)

II. Owner Responsibilities:

- 1. Maintenance, repair or replacement items not allocated to the HOA including:
 - Aggregate driveway, walkway to front entry & front entry. (See Page 4)
 - > Patio
 - > Steps, stairways, decks and exterior trim on screened-in decks, seasonal rooms and support posts.
 - > Entry doors front (board approved) and rear
 - > Garage doors (board approved)
 - ➤ All screens and glass surfaces including skylights
 - Coach lights
 - > Mailboxes
 - Owner installed landscaping (including trees, shrubs, flowers/plants, decorative rock, landscape lighting, border walls natural or manufactured) and all owner or previous owner landscaping in back of villas.
